

TRAVEL GRANT APPLICATION

The Association of Washington International Student Affairs, AWISA, connects Washington's international educators. AWISA meetings provide quarterly opportunities for professional development, networking, project collaboration and more; members share the common goal of promoting and improving international education. "AWISAns" are Washingtonians and members of the global community.

Members include international student and scholar advisors, study abroad advisors, international admissions specialists, student activity coordinators, high school advisors, and ESL advisors—just to name some of the represented areas of specialization—as well as individuals looking to learn more about the field of international education such as graduate students and community members. AWISA meetings feature sessions on a wide range of topics, from intercultural communication to credential evaluation, from study abroad information to F-1 and J-1 regulatory discussions presented by a wide array of people. Members also receive regulatory updates, local job announcements, networking opportunities, and notices about special events by email. AWISA's activities and session topics are driven by current members and leadership, so new members, presenters and ideas are always welcome!

AWISA is pleased to offer travel grants for the NAFSA Regional Conference which is generally held in October/November. Please read below for eligibility, instructions, conditions, and information on applying.

Eligibility:

- Must be working, studying, or living in Washington State.
- AWISA members and non-members are eligible to apply.
- We encourage AWISA members, presenters, graduate students (in international education, student affairs, or similar program), volunteers, interns, etc. to apply.

Conditions:

- AWISA is offering 3 travel grants in the maximum amount of \$500.00 each for the fall 2011 NAFSA Regional Conference.
- AWISA Travel Grants are to be used exclusively towards attending the NAFSA Region I Conference. If conference costs are less than Travel Grant amount, the recipient will only be given funds toward the conference. No profit will be made.
- Recipients must have a hotel roommate or pay the difference on their own. The award will only apply toward ½ the nightly cost of the hotel for conference days.
- NAFSA Travel Grant recipients may also be granted the AWISA Travel Grant; the NAFSA grant will be considered the primary
 grant. AWISA will only pay the difference in costs with a maximum amount of the total AWISA Travel Grant. In order to
 receive the funding, NAFSA Travel Grant recipients must submit receipts and an expense report detailing how much was
 funded by NAFSA and what needs to be funded by AWISA.
- AWISA Travel Grant Recipients must either have Chaired, presented, or organized a session or panel within the past year (from the NAFSA Regional Conference start date) or will do so up to 1 year after the conference.
- A maximum of \$500.00 will be paid to each recipient for fall 2011.

Process:

- Applications are due to Jen Gruver (<u>JGruver@pierce.ctc.edu</u>) via email by **September 1, 2011**. Late and/or incomplete applications will not be considered.
- Applicants will be informed of decisions via email by September 30, 2011.
- Travel Grants will be paid to recipients approximately 2 weeks after submission of expense reports, except for those also being awarded the NAFSA Region I Travel Grant who will be reimbursed approximately 1 month after submitting receipts and expense reports. However, if an advance is necessary, please contact the AWISA Chair directly.
